## **Status Summary**

Since the last status report, our team has continued to work on the various components of our project. ## **Past Week Accomplishments**

### ***Koby Fowler***

- With the team finally coming together and completing most of a round trip and completing project functionality, I have switched completely to frontend focus and wrapping up the project nicely.

- Worked alongside Raghu to design and implement new tables for a comprehensive 4-year degree program database.

- Focused on collecting, organizing, and saving data in distinct columns to ensure structured storage. Successfully able to store all program data in the tables in a single column for now.

## **Pending Issues**

### ***Upcoming Merge Conflicts - 11/14/24***

- **Anna - Status: Resolved**
  - Previously, when working to merge with Christian's userinfo2 branch, there were many merge conflicts with existing/differing node-modules. This was resolved by removing these packages and re-installing them. I also resolved the additional merge conflicts outside of node-modules.

## **Plans for the Upcoming Week**

### ***Koby Fowler***

- Continue frontend overhaul and look into project postboard completion.

### ***Chandrashekar Tirunagiri***

- Will connect backed to userinfo page.
- We'll proceed with AI integration for the four-year degree plan, where the AI will recommend classes by analyzing and comparing the degree audit with the structured four-year degree plan
- Develop a class schedule page featuring a calendar view that displays classes for the upcoming semester. For now, we'll use mock data since we don't have access to Iowa State's Workday API key due to privacy restrictions.

### ***Raghuram Guddati***

- Will work with Chan to test and enhance code, ensuring data is stored in separate columns and optimizing table structure for more efficient data storage.
- Additionally, collaborate with Chan and Jacob to establish AI integration, performing roundtrip tests to confirm smooth data retrieval and interaction between the AI and database systems.
